GYPROC CORNER TAPE

Overview

Gyproc Corner Tape is a paper joint tape bonded to two steel strips.

Where to use

Use it to reinforce external angle joints in plasterboard constructions.

Product information

Composition

This product is made from paper with metal strips.

Colour

White

Width (mm)

Installation

Cutting

Cut to length with snips, allowing for some thermal movement, e.g. a piece for a 2.4m floor to ceiling joint should be cut with 3mm clearance in length.

Fixing

Check boarding for secure fixing and damage and correct if necessary.

Cut to length, mitring corners around window openings etc.

Apply a coat of Gyproc Joint Filler or Gyproc EasiFill to both sides of the joint.

Pre-fold the Gyproc Corner Tape to the correct angle and carefully press into the jointing compound, ensuring there is no trapped air and that the alignment is correct. Remove excess joint compound and allow to set.

Finish the joint by applying further coat(s) as required, feathered out onto the face of the boards, using any suitable Gyproc finishing compound (not Gyproc Joint Filler for the final coat).

When fully dry, sand to a final finish taking care not to damage the paper, and decorate.

Packaging overview

30m roll in cardboard dispensing carton, 5 boxes per carton.

Quantity per carton	5 rolls
Quantity per pallet	80 boxes

Storage

Store in a dry place and keep out of sunlight.

Recyclability

This product can be recycled with paper in accordance with local authority requirements.

Disposal

Segregate the product from non-gypsum waste for recycling where possible, and dispose of it according to local authority requirements.
