

Saint Gobain Construction Products (Ireland) Ltd. are required to submit an AER (Annual Environmental Report) each year under their IED Licence P0519-04 (Industrial Emissions Directive) issued by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA)

What is an AER?

An Annual Environmental Report is an end of year report that summarises the environmental performance of the company. It is a legal requirement to submit this AER by the 31st March each year to the EPA. An EPR (Environmental Performance Report) is also submitted to the EPA. This EPR is a detailed and quantified inventory all environmental emissions and also details all wastes produced from site operations.

What is reported in the SGCPI AER?

Environmental performance on key indicators such as:

- Emissions to air summary
- Stormwater emissions to receiving waters summary
- Environmental Complaints and Incidents summary (if any)
- Waste management and shipments summary
- Bund and pipeline integrity testing
- Noise and Vibration monitoring
- Water & Energy use and efficiency
- Impacts on groundwaters and land
- Environmental Targets and Objectives for the past and coming year
