

## Scrim & Gyproc Finish Plaster

To maintain performance claims made within the Gyproc White Book, regular benchmark testing and system evaluation is undertaken.

While the tape and jointing process using Gyproc Paper Joint Tape bedded into an appropriate Gyproc jointing filler remains our best practice recommendation and offers a higher quality and stronger joint, further to recent testing and appraisals, with respect to all systems contained within the Gyproc White Book, we confirm:

Gyproc systems may also achieve their stated fire, sound insulation and duty performance claims using a full surface treatment of 2mm Gyproc finishing plasters, applied as per Gyproc's current recommendations, over scrim taped joints; in lieu of the tape and jointing process using Gyproc Paper Joint Tape bedded into an appropriate Gyproc jointing filler.

## **Application note:**

Where scrim tape is used, the plaster must be pushed through the scrim tape well into any gaps between boards & fully pushed into the scrim tape and taper.
